TVR POOL RULES (Effective 6/3/21)

POOL HOURS: MONDAY - SATURDAY 9 AM - DUSK, SUNDAY 11:00 AM - DUSK

- 1. Everyone entering the pool area <u>must</u> sign the registration book.
- 2. You must wear a bathing suit when entering the pool. Only swimwear will be permitted in the pool. (*No street clothes, and no cotton or cotton blends.*)
- 3. Children 16 years of age and under must be accompanied by an adult resident. Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult while in the pool and must use a USCG approved personal flotation device at all times, unless the child has taken and passed an approved swimming class. (A copy of the certificate must be provided to the office for exemption of this rule.)
- 4. Residents wishing to bring guests totaling more than 4 must notify the office in advance. The Unit Owner accepts any and all responsibility and liability for their actions and for any claims that may arise as a result of their actions. Residents must accompany their guests at all times. When the resident leaves the pool area, the guests must leave as well.
- 5. To avoid possible conflicts and overcrowding, all parties, large groups, holiday celebration, etc. must be submitted to council 3 days prior to the function. All functions must end by 7:00pm and all trash, food debris, cans, etc. must be placed in trash bags, fastened closed and placed in the dumpster outside the building's back door.
- 6. Infants in diapers are not permitted in the pool. They are allowed in the pool area only, but must wear a snug waterproof diaper cover.
- 7. Personal music devices at poolside must be used with a headset.
- 8. No glass containers are allowed in the pool area; only plastic & paper are permitted.
- 9. Everyone is required to clean up after themselves. Smokers must bring and use ashtrays.
- 10. Running around the pool area and rough behavior in or out of the pool will not be permitted.
- 11. Diving is prohibited.
- 12. No pets are permitted in the swimming pool or pool area.
- 13. Persons suffering from a communicable illness, skin diseases, eye, nose or throat infections or persons having any open wounds, whether bandaged or not, are prohibited from using the pool.
- 14. No quantity of straight unmixed hard alcohol may be brought into the pool area. Personal mixed drinks in quantities less than 16 ounces are allowed but must be in a personal plastic container.

Anyone using the pool or pool area does so at their own risk and cannot hold the Towers of Valley Run or any of their members personally liable or responsible for any accident or loss of personal property.

All injuries, however slight, must be reported to the office as soon as possible, 302-475-9146.

COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS (Effective 6/3/21) Guests Are Permitted

- Risk of SARS-CoV-2 infection is minimal for fully <u>vaccinated</u> people. The risk of SARS-CoV-2 transmission from fully vaccinated people to unvaccinated people is also reduced. Therefore, fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask or physically distancing, except where required by federal, state, or local laws, rules, and regulations.
- The prevention measures listed below are still recommended for unvaccinated people:
 - Everyone 2 years and older should wear masks in public.
 - Masks should be worn in addition to staying at least 6 feet apart, especially around people who don't live with you.
 - Put 6 feet of distance between yourself and people who don't live in your household.
- All persons are encouraged to wash hands often (with soap and water for at least 20 seconds) and cover your coughs or sneezes. Hand sanitizers are available at the sign-in table and restroom for your use.
- Bathers should review the signs and symptoms of COVID-19 before heading to the pool. Do not enter the pool area if you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.
- Any person found sick with COVID-19 symptoms in the pool area should be isolated and someone from Council contacted so transportation arrangements can be made, if needed, along with disinfecting the areas used by the sick person. The Division of Public Health (302-744-4700) and any close contacts should be notified.
- Non-compliance of these restrictions must be reported to the office. This is OUR pool and in order for it to remain open, we must follow the rules and regulations.

BARBEQUE GRILL
